Raymond Burley is one of Britain's most experienced guitarists. As a soloist, he has toured extensively throughout the UK, Europe, North and South America and the Far East. He has performed and recorded with many of England's finest orchestras including the English Chamber Orchestra, the Philharmonia and the BBC Symphony Orchestra.

He has premiered works by composers that include Stephen Dodgson, Bernard Stevens, Reginald Smith Brindle, John Duarte, James Patten, Gilbert Biberian and Dudley Moore. He has performed and recorded in duo with guitarists Alice Artzt, John Mills, Gordon Giltrap, Gregg Nestor, Clive Carroll, John Feeley, John Etheridge and Giorgio Mirto; other partners include actress Dame Peggy Ashcroft, harpsichordist Gilbert Rowland, mezzo-soprano Jacqueline Fox and keyboard player Rick Wakeman.

Raymond Burley has given masterclasses and directed guitar festivals in the UK, Vancouver, Ottawa, Toronto, Calgary, Seattle, San Francisco, Salt Lake City, Washington DC, New York, Princeton, Kowloon, Dublin, Bonn, Bremen and Lima. He has numerous recordings to his credit and publications with d'OZ (Canada), Durand (France), Schott and Corda (UK), PWM (Poland).
